Operations

Programs

MIT Aurangabad will be responsible for providing the infrastructure for running the MAGIC sessions. We will need access to high-speed internet and a projector besides the basic facilities provided at the MIT Aurangabad. MAGIC and MIT Aurangabad will create a small board of advisors that meet once quarterly (using video conferencing) to share the progress and setting goals for MIT Aurangabad. MAGIC will take care of meeting strict quality requirements for all the programs and will be directly responsible for running and managing all programs at MIT Aurangabad. Based on the calendar of events, listed out on

MAGIC website and digital media publications, 10-12 programs a year will be directly carried out by MAGIC by Mentors/Experts with additional faculties from outside Aurangabad. From time-to-time guest lecturers and experts will be invited.

Post Program Support and Mentorship; MAGIC will design activities and create a strategy for MIT Aurangabad to continue the supporting the participants post program. This activity will be designed keeping in mind the annual programming calendar and the mentorship access provided through the vast network of MAGIC by CMIA.

Student recruitment for programs MIT Aurangabad will be directly overseeing the responsibility of engaging local educational institutions, stakeholders to invite students for the workshops. Marketing using press release, blogs and social media will be a shared responsibility. MIT Aurangabad will help us connecting to local colleges and universities and also possibly attract more students engaging with our programs. MAGIC with support such activities in its full capacity through guest talks and lectures.

Both, MAGIC and MIT Aurangabad will create a shared press release for distribution. This will clearly highlight the foundation of the relationship on how we are on path for making MIT Aurangabad a center of excellence in entrepreneurship and innovation in the Marathwada region.
